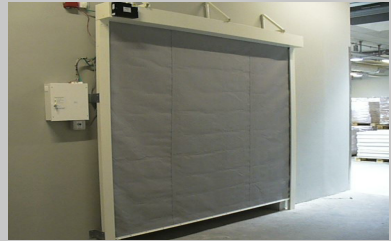

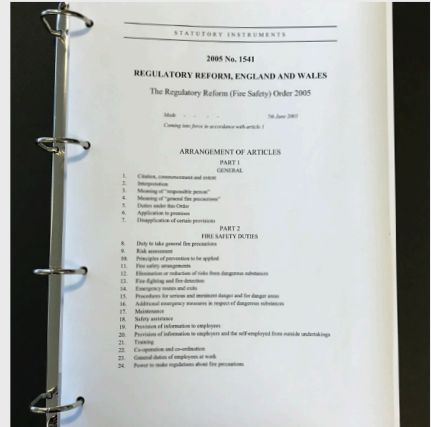
- Service and maintenance is a mandatory legal requirement for ALL life safety systems, including smoke and fire curtains

About Servicing

Why Do I Need to Service My Smoke & Fire Curtains?

Smoke and fire curtains are **life safety systems**.

Designed to prevent the spread of smoke and fire through a building, they help protect human life in the event of an emergency.



It is a **legal requirement** that **ALL** life safety systems are **regularly serviced and maintained**, as outlined below.

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (Section 17, part 1),

“17.(1) Where necessary in order to safeguard the safety of relevant persons the responsible person must ensure that the **premises and any facilities, equipment and devices** provided in respect of the premises under this Order or, subject to paragraph (6), under any other enactment, including any enactment repealed or revoked by this Order, are subject to a **suitable system of maintenance** and are **maintained** in an **efficient state**, in **efficient working order** and in **good repair**.”

Booking A Service

How Often Do I Need to Service?

The frequency of service and maintenance required is determined by various factors, including the use and occupancy of the building.

BLE offer a number of comprehensive service packages to maintain installed smoke and fire curtains including emergency call outs for malfunctioned barriers, whatever the cause.

How Can BLE Help?

BLE can provide servicing for all existing types of BLE smoke & fire curtains - whether we installed them or if they were installed by a BLE distributor.

Unfortunately we are not able to offer service packages for none BLE systems. However we are able to quote for a BLE replacement curtain, which would then be eligible for one of our service packages.

Annual Service Packages

We offer a variety of service packages to suit your needs:

- 1 year package (1 x visit)
- 2 year package (2x visits - 1 x per year)
- 3 year package (3x visits total - 1 x per year)

The Small Print

BLE service contracts are issued on the following assumptions:

- Full uninterrupted access to all BLE equipment must be available at the time of engineers visit.
- This service visit does not include any consumable products other than battery replacement if required (not holding power/ not working as should or older than 2 years).
- This service visit does not include any replacement parts, damaged or not working, these will be reported at the time, optional purchases and installation may be available subject to the engineers stock and time availability.
- Mains power and fire signal connections to GCP by others.
- A permanent stable power supply is available for commissioning / servicing.
- Provision of access equipment above 3m will not be provided by BLE.
- Full clear access to the work area will be available for the duration of the service.
- Subsequent visits will be charged at £850.00 per day or part day.
- If a separate visit or visits are required; up to 10 days notice will be given to attend site.
- Full access to the headbox and electrical equipment will be available for maintenance.
- All builders' works relating to the service of the curtain system will be provided by others.
